SUBJECT: Request for Best and Final Offer – Solid Waste Management Services (RFP #2526-003)

Dear Mr. Avalos

In response to the subject RFP's Official Notice #3 dated April 19, 2026, Valley Vista Services, Inc. ("Valley Vista" or "VVS") thanks the City for the opportunity to provide our Best and Final Offer (BAFO) for the City of Fullerton's ("City's") Request for Proposals for Solid Waste Management Services (or the "RFP").

Drawing on our 68 years and four generations of local operation, management, and service experience which currently encompasses more than 112,000 residential customers and 25,000 commercial customers across Southern California, and leveraging our assets such as our \$35M High Diversion Organic Waste Processing Facility, +380 vehicle fleet, and nearly 500 personnel, we are proud to present this BAFO which we feel meets and exceeds those items identified and discussed by staff, the City Council, and public comments at the Study Session held on April 14, 2026. We also believe that this BAFO strikes the correct balance between robust community support and insulation of rate payers from subsidizing proposal enhancements, thereby providing the City what we believe is the best value overall.

Valley Vista hereby confirms that all proposed services and enhancements in our most recent proposal are still and will continue to be valid throughout the term of this RFP.

To briefly summarize our most recent proposal, VVS has committed to:

1. Opening an administrative office and customer service center in Downtown Fullerton on Harbor Boulevard
2. Operating a completely new RNG-fueled collection fleet at an identified industrial property less than 1,000 feet from City boundaries
3. Guaranteeing demonstrable processing and transfer capacity for all waste streams at our City of Industry MRF
4. Implementing a robust organics recycling program including up to six (6) community outreach meetings, direct mailings of educational materials, free residential organic waste collection containers and regular and sustained educational outreach which is fully compliant with all applicable regulations, especially SB 1383 and AB 1826 throughout the entire term of the franchise
5. Providing up to two (2) customer service representatives for staffing a help desk at City Hall throughout the transition period

6. In accordance with State law, VVS will offer employment to incumbent hauler's qualified employees, which includes competitive compensation as well as an industry-leading employee benefits package encompassing 401K matching, an employee life insurance policy as well as health, vision, and dental coverage for the employee, their spouse and even their dependents.
7. **As stated in our proposal, every franchised jurisdiction we serve is compliant with SB 1383 regulations**

In addition, we propose the following services and enhancements:

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Dedicated Labor Commitment

Supplementing our proposed staffing levels, Valley Vista is proposing to dedicate additional labor resources to ensure quality of service and compliance with State requirements, especially SB 1383.

- A total of six (6) dedicated recycling coordinators throughout the entirety of the transition period. VVS proposes to deploy our Sustainability Team six (6) months prior to service commencement. Drawing on our recent successes transitioning East Los Angeles, Diamond Bar, and especially our early transition in Huntington Park, we're confident that six (6) months will provide enough time not only for initial contact, right-sizing, and application for potential organics recycling waivers, but also trouble shooting potential service issues. We anticipate to visit every commercial establishment in the City during this period.
- Following the initial transition period, VVS will dedicate three (3) recycling coordinators to the City throughout the entire term of the agreement.

City-wide Abandoned Item Sweeps

VVS proposes implementing weekly city-wide sweeps to collect abandoned and illegally dumped items throughout the City. We will also collect abandoned items reported by our drivers, the City and residents as they occur.

Annual Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off

In order to prevent hazardous waste disposal in the regular waste stream, VVS is proposing to increase access to safe hazardous waste disposal by hosting an annual hazardous waste drop off event in coordination with the City.

Additional Residential Recycling Carts

At no additional charge, VVS will provide residential customers an additional 96-gallon residential blue and green cart on request.

Incidental Waste Collection

VVS proposes to provide incidental waste collection to residential customers. Residents may request collection of bagged incidental waste free of charge, up to twenty (20) bags per year. After scheduling, residents may simply leave their bagged incidental waste next to their collection container on their regular trash day.

Downtown Fullerton Service

Valley Vista Services proposes a comprehensive City of Fullerton Downtown District Program designed to efficiently serve high-density, mixed-use environments while maintaining service reliability, cleanliness, and cost control.

The Fullerton Downtown District Program is structured to support shared-service waste and recycling collection among multiple tenants and property types utilizing common containers. This approach maximizes operational efficiency, reduces congestion, and aligns with best practices for urban collection systems.

Services will include:

- Scheduled collection of solid waste, recyclables, and organics
- Strategic container placement to minimize public right-of-way obstruction
- Enhanced servicing frequency to meet higher demand and maintain cleanliness standards
- Coordination with property managers and business owners to ensure proper usage and compliance
- Regular power washing and porter service for all bin enclosures throughout the Downtown District

Shared-Service Pricing Structure

Valley Vista Services will implement a transparent and equitable pricing model for shared-service recipients. Costs will be allocated based on service level, container size, collection frequency, and the number of participating customers.

While multiple-customer billing arrangements typically require additional administrative and operational resources, Valley Vista Services will absorb all associated premium costs and will not pass these expenses on to customers. This approach reflects our commitment to promoting shared-service participation, reducing barriers to entry, and delivering cost-effective solutions within the Downtown District.

Valley Vista Services will ensure that shared-service arrangements remain cost-effective compared to individual container service wherever feasible.

Upon contract award, Valley Vista Services will conduct in-person site surveys to ensure each customer is properly assessed and billed in accordance with their specific service needs.

Multiple Customer Billing Capability

Valley Vista Services confirms its ability to support **multiple customer billings tied to a single container**, including:

- Account segmentation and proportional cost allocation
- Clear invoicing for each participating customer
- Ongoing customer support to address billing inquiries

Our systems and administrative infrastructure are fully equipped to manage these arrangements accurately and efficiently.

Service Frequency Commitment

Valley Vista Services confirms that it **can provide up to seven (7) days per week collection service** within the Fullerton Downtown District, if required. Service frequency will be tailored to:

- Customer demand and waste generation levels
- Site-specific constraints
- City requirements and performance standards

Valley Vista Services is confident that this approach provides a balanced solution that meets operational demands while maintaining fairness and transparency in pricing.

ADDITIONAL ENHANCEMENTS

Community Involvement

In order to assist the City in its evaluation, VVS has estimated dollar amounts for our community involvement commitments stated in our proposal.

- Annual Donations to Local Organizations including but not limited to:
 - Fullerton Heritage – Benefactor Membership and donation totaling \$5,000.00
 - Love Fullerton – Participate in the annual Volunteer Day and donate \$1,500.00

 - Fullerton Bears Football and Cheer – Sponsorship \$1,000.00

Workforce Training Program

In order to formulate a career pathway for local students the VVS team met with Ken Starkman and his team at Fullerton College on 12/12/2025 to discuss a plan whereby a formalized workforce pipeline could be created for recruiting, training, and placing local individuals into various roles, including drivers, mechanics, and customer service representatives.

Senior Citizen Discount

VVS proposes to establish a discount program for the City's senior citizens. We propose a ten percent (10%) discount on final residential rates to all qualified seniors throughout the City.

Enhanced Scholarship Program

VVS is proposing to enhance our proposed scholarship program by increasing individual scholarship amounts to \$2,000.00, bringing the total allocated annual scholarship amount to \$20,000.00.

Annual Art Contest and Scholarship

In addition to our proposed academic scholarship program, VVS is proposing to establish an art contest and scholarship program for City students. VVS will administer an annual art contest for City residents applying for or have committed to a visual or performing arts program following their graduation from high school. VVS will award a \$2,000.00 scholarship to the grand prize winner, as well as three scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each to the remaining top four participants.

Recovered Organic Waste Product (ROWP) Procurement

As stated in our proposal, VVS is willing and able to provide credits for City ROWP procurement requirements. Through our partnerships with organic waste processors and leveraging our pre-processing capabilities at our City of Industry High Diversion Organic Waste Processing Facility, VVS is able to transfer ROWP credits and provide supporting documentation for incorporation into the City's implementation record. VVS can commit to procure ROWPs valued up to \$250,000.00 annually.

Additionally, VVS has also observed success meeting State ROWP requirements by providing mulch and compost for use by residents, businesses, and the City at parks and other open space areas. VVS commits to providing unlimited compost and mulch for City use. We will also provide compost and mulch for resident self-service at a site designated by the City, as well as bagged compost on a semi-annual basis.

No-Cost Street Sweeping

Upon expiration of the current sweeping services contract, VVS is prepared to offer the City street sweeping services at no additional cost.

RESPONSE TO CITY'S QUESTIONS

Regarding the City's questions about the potential delay of the franchise agreement award until September 2026, Valley Vista responds as follows:

Will this impact your ability to have all new vehicles operational by July 1, 2027? If yes, please explain.

The potential delay of awarding the franchise agreement until September 2026 may impact the timeline to fully deploy new collection vehicles throughout the City. As a contingency, Valley Vista has placed an order for new collection vehicles to service approximately 75% of the City by July 1, 2027. We remain committed to procuring an entirely new fleet for servicing the City, but we acknowledge the possibility that we may need to deploy used vehicles. VVS currently owns and anticipates delivery of enough vehicles to commence service on July 1, 2027 and fully roll out all proposed collection programs. Any used vehicles deployed in the City shall be temporary, and vehicle vintages will not exceed 5 years.

Will this impact your ability to have all required containers in place by July 1, 2027? If yes, please explain.

No. Valley Vista can continue to commit to deploying all required containers on or before July 1, 2027.

Will this impact your ability to roll out all required SB 1383 collection programs by July 1, 2027? If yes, please explain.

No. Valley Vista currently employs sufficient staff including operations supervisors, auditors, and recycling coordinators. VVS commits to meeting complete roll out of all required SB 1383 collection programs on or before July 1, 2027.

Finally, we feel that our qualifications, capabilities, and innovation in organic waste recycling were not accurately represented in the final analysis presented to Council at the special meeting of April 14, 2026. All current municipalities and county unincorporated areas we serve are *fully* and *completely* in compliance with all organics recycling mandates not only relating to collection, but also outreach and education, contamination monitoring and route reviews, and especially reporting. VVS in partnership with our commonly owned and controlled affiliate Grand Central Recycling & Transfer Station, Inc. (GCR), operates a state-of-the-art material recovery facility and transfer station in the City of Industry. Our facility maintains the proud designation as a **High Diversion Organic Waste Processing Facility (HDOWPF)** by **CalRecycle** – the only currently operating *and certified* facility in Southern California, located less than fifteen (15) miles from Fullerton's city limits. Our investment in pre-processing in coordination with a heavy emphasis on community education is proving successful. As stated in our proposal, every franchised jurisdiction we serve is compliant with SB 1383 regulations. Further, our ongoing route audits and waste analyses show positive and sustained trends in program participation and landfill diversion.


